WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Sathianathans: Praise God for the gift that Godwin has been to our church in his years serving as our pastor. Give praise to God for the gift that Jeni and their children have been to us, as well. Pray for them as they say goodbye to us and transition to their new church family in northern Virginia. Pray that they would hope in God and rest in his salvation (Psalm 62). Pray that we would give thanks to God for every remembrance of them, praying with joy because of our partnership in the gospel (Philippians 1:3-4).

Our Elders: Pray that our elders will have great wisdom as they seek to lead our church through this next season. Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Timothy 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3).

Our Generosity: Ask that the Lord would grow our church in having generous hearts. May the abundance of God's goodness to us overflow in giving of our time, talent, and treasure. May we give cheerfully, not under compulsion. May the Lord see fit to use our gifts for his good purpose of building his kingdom (2 Corinthians 8-9).

Pete and Betsy Baglow: Pray for the Baglows, ministry partners we support who serve with Cru at the University of Massachusetts. They flew out on May 27th with a team of college students to the Middle East where they will be evangelizing students. Pray for the students' hearts to be soft to the gospel and for their team to be bold in the truth of the gospel. They will be there through the end of June.

Other Gospel-Preaching Churches: Pray for other evangelical churches in our area. Pray they would continue to proclaim the excellencies of Christ and that they would remain committed to teach the whole counsel of God. Pray the Lord would continue to build his church and establish healthy local churches throughout Cincinnati and beyond.
