WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Spiritual Warfare: Pray that we will put on the full armor of God to engage in the spiritual war around us. May we put on truth, righteousness, the gospel, faith, salvation, and prayer. (Eph. 6:10-20). May we be sober minded and alert regarding the schemes of the devil, always resisting him (1 Peter 5:8-9).

Our Governing Authorities: Pray for our current governing authorities, like Governor DeWine, President Biden, and others (1 Tim. 2:1-4). Pray that they would lead with character, wisdom, and care for all. Pray for effective governmental leadership, “so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity.”

Ed and Linda Cox | The Navigators Indiana Prison Ministry: Pray for Linda who has stopped chemotherapy. She has lost a lot of weight, is very weak, and unable to walk due to her bone cancer pain. In spite of these trials Ed and Linda continue to minister to the people around them. Many of the ex-inmates are stopping by to visit them. Pray for Sam to continue on his spiritual journey toward Jesus and pray for Vic, an ex-con who is on fire to minister to others. Ed hopes Sam and Vic can connect.

Our Community Groups: Pray for our various community groups as they meet throughout the week. Pray they would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced & preserved. Pray for us to eagerly practice the “one-anothers” of the New Testament. Pray our groups would be places where we love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another’s burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phil. 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond. Pray that we as a church would be faithful to contribute to the needs of the saints (Rom. 13:12) giving cheerfully, generously, and sacrificially (1 Cor. 16:2; 2 Cor. 8:1-5, 12; 9:6-7).

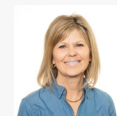

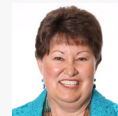

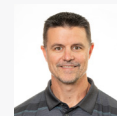
