Interested in becoming a member at Faith Church? Want to know what that means? Join us after church **today** for our Membership Class led by our pastors. Lunch and childcare will be provided.

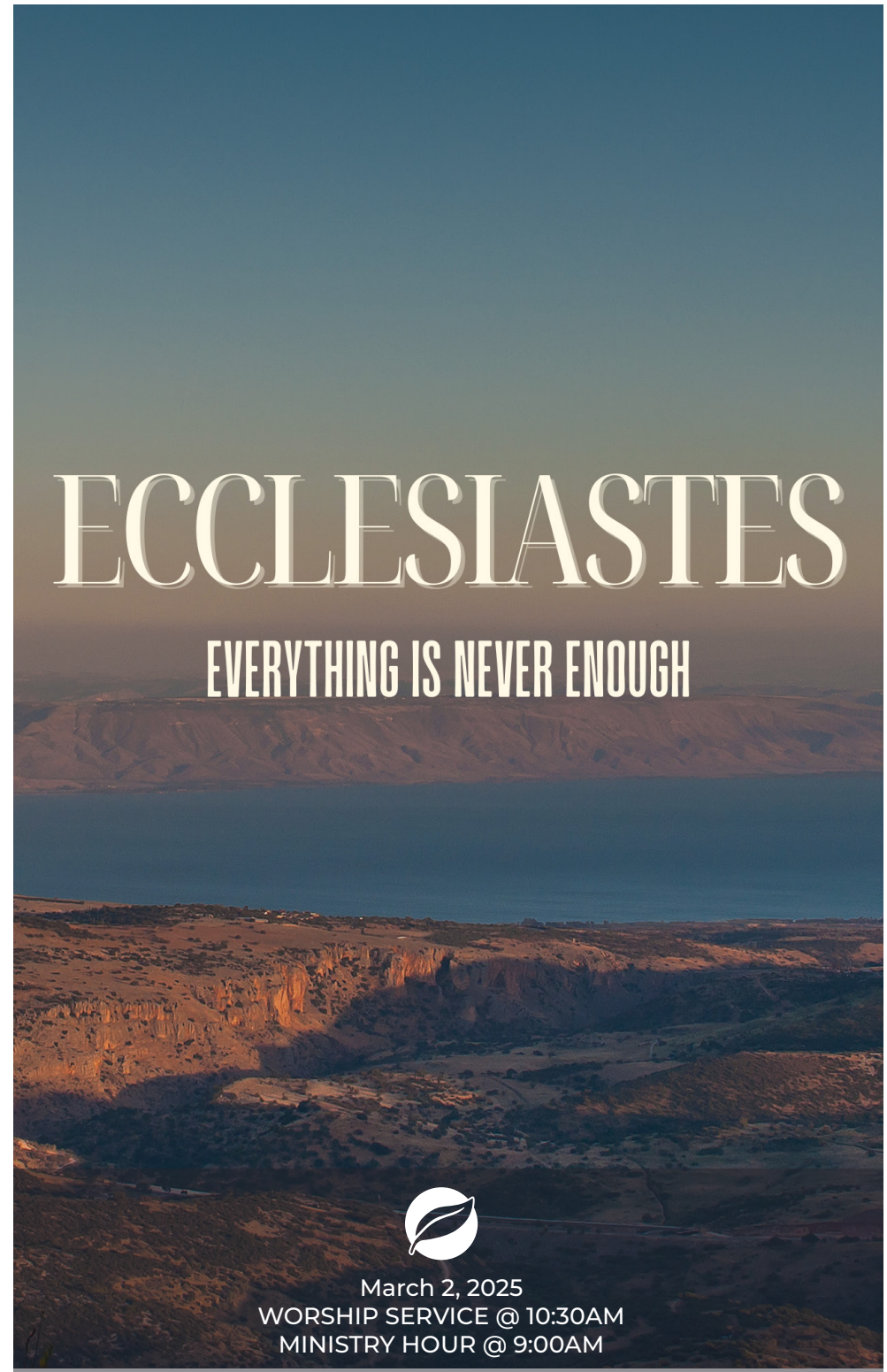
Moms & Sons Night Apr 4 // 7-9pm // MPR

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Governing Authorities: Pray for our current governing authorities like Pres. Trump and Gov. Mike DeWine (1 Tim. 2:1-4). Pray they would lead with character, wisdom, and care for all. Pray for effective governmental leadership, “so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity.”

A Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Lk. 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (Jas. 4:8). Ask that by God’s grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Rom. 8:26).

Karen Norton: Pray for Karen to experience continued relationships with Anjeza, Mela, Lidi, London, Jen, and Edona. Pray she would be bold in sharing about her own faith and asking good questions of them and that they would come to know Jesus as their Lord. Pray for a grateful heart and contentment in the Lord and in what he has provided for her—her team and a church family. Pray for humility, grace, and unity within the team. Pray the Lord would continue to guide her as she thinks about decisions for next year.

Ashley Friedland and Lynda Wick: Pray for Ashley and Lynda as they move to Southeast Asia and Papua New Guinea, respectively. Pray the Lord fills them with all comfort and peace as they make a big transition to the countries they are serving. Pray the logistics of getting settled and getting acquainted with their ministry partners goes well. Pray their ministries will bear long-term fruit for Christ.

A Witnessing Church: Pray the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips and we will always be prepared to give reasons for the hope that is in us (1 Pet. 3:15). Ask that many doors will open for the word and we will declare the mystery of Christ with clarity and winsomeness (Col. 3:3-4). Pray many unbelievers who visit our church and interact with our people will be converted and able to say, “We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the Savior of the world” (Jn. 4:42).

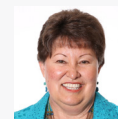
