WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

For the Nations: Pray that all the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord and that every family of every nation will worship the Lord (Ps. 22:27). Pray that every people, nation, and language will serve King Jesus (Dan. 7:14). Choose one nation in particular and pray for it each day this week that Jesus might be glorified there and much good would come to the people. Rejoice and praise God that by his blood, Jesus has ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation (Rev. 5:9).

The Elders and the Search Team: Continue to pray for the elders and the search team as they begin working towards a new lead pastor. Pray that the Spirit will give them wisdom and skill as they think through the process.

Our Homebound Members: There are members who wish they could join us on Sunday mornings but are unable to do so due to health and physical limitations. Please pray for their spiritual and emotional health and strength in the midst of their difficult challenges and for their ability to be comforted by God's presence. Pray we would be intentional and faithful to visit with them and encourage them.

Our Congregational Singing: Pray we would be a church that delights to "sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly" (Ps. 149:1). Pray that we would sing with full hearts as an act of love toward God and one another. Pray we would see our singing on Sundays as expressions of our faith and thankfulness to God and as a means to teach, admonish, and encourage one another (Eph. 5:18-20).

Other Gospel-Preaching Churches: Pray for other evangelical churches in our area. Pray they would continue to proclaim the excellencies of Christ and would remain committed to teach the whole counsel of God. Pray the Lord would continue to build his church and establish healthy local churches throughout Cincinnati and beyond.
