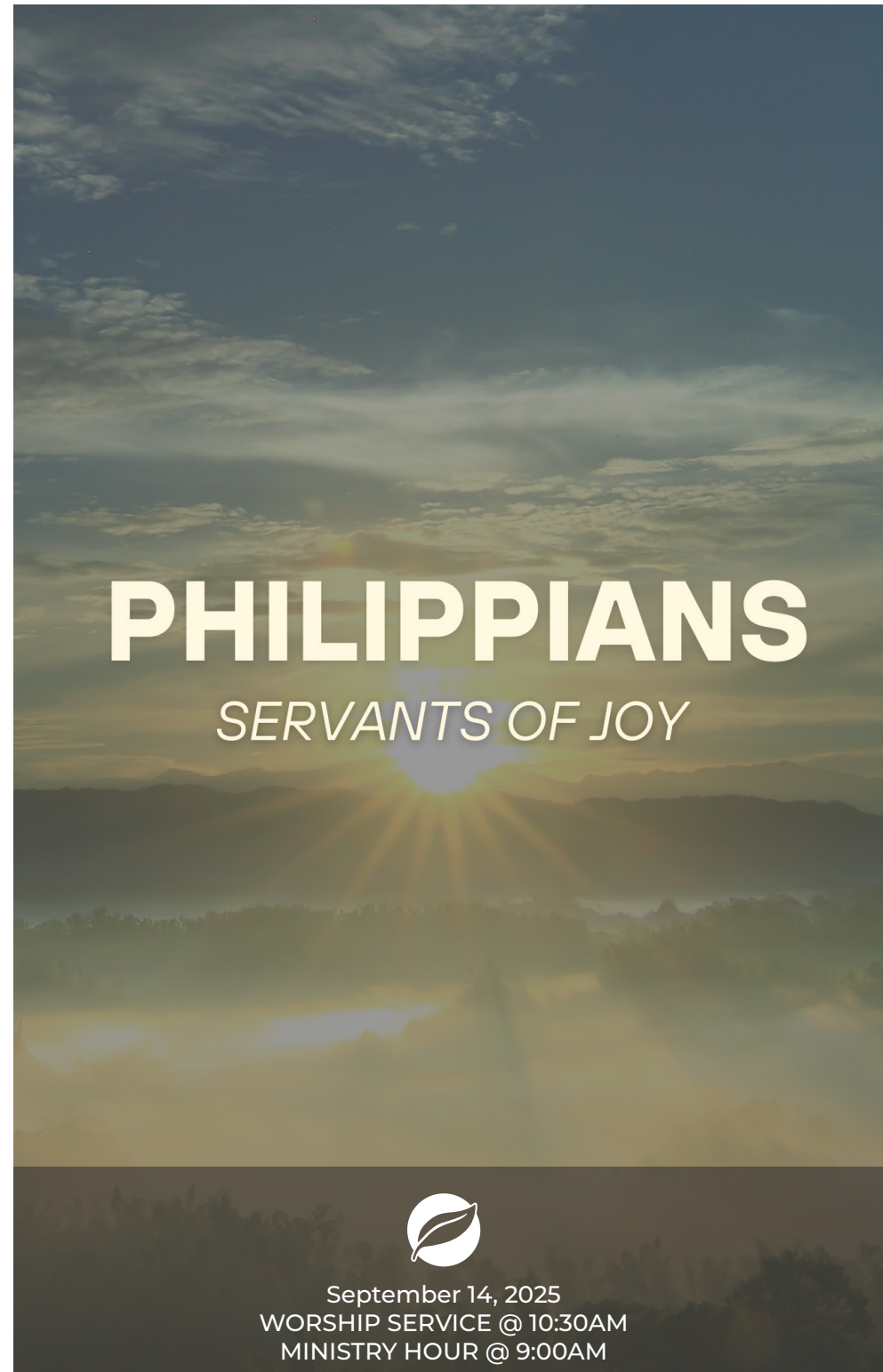

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together (John 17:20-26). May our gospel unity be a powerful witness to the truth of Jesus' love.

Fall Women's Bible Studies: As our fall women's Bible studies just began, pray that they bear spiritual fruit. May the women involved be more joyful in God, more convicted of sin, and more connected to one another. May the teachers be encouraged and energized in their prep.

Chris and Lisa Phillips: Pray for Chris and Lisa Phillips as they serve in their new church plant in East Asia. Pray for Chris as he bears the load of being the main preaching pastor. Pray for their kids to grow in wisdom and stature. Pray that many would be saved through the witness of their church.

May we put the interests of others over our own interests (Philippians 2:4). In doing that, may we be increasingly like Jesus (Philippians 2:5). Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously give new and eternal life to particular unbelievers who are connected to our members as we welcome them to church or in our homes (John 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mark 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Assurance of Pardon

After the confession, there will be an assurance of pardon moment. Often this will be taken from the scriptures, assuring Christians that God has pardoned their guilt, taken their sin away, and accepts them as His children forever (Psalm 103:1-8; Luke 7:48-50; John 3:16-17). Open your heart, each week, to be reminded of God's gracious pardon.
