WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Congregational Singing: Pray we would be a church that delights to “sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly” (Ps. 149:1). Pray that we would sing with full hearts as an act of love toward God and one another. Pray we would see our singing on Sundays as expressions of our faith and thankfulness to God and as a means to teach, admonish, and encourage one another (Eph. 5:18-20).

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together especially as we go through this time of transition in our church (John 17:20-26).

Fruit from the Preaching of God’s Word: Pray that God’s Word, as it’s preached each week, will do its work of rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness so that we would be “made complete, equipped for every good work” (2 Tim. 3:16-17). Pray for our pastors, as they labor each week, to preach faithfully, clearly, with great patience, in Christ-exalting ways, and in accordance with sound doctrine (2 Tim. 4:1-3).

For the Nations: Pray that all the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord and that every family of every nation will worship the Lord (Psalm 22:27). Pray that every people, nation, and language will serve King Jesus (Dan. 7:14). Choose one nation and pray for it each day this week that Jesus might be glorified there and much good would come to the people. Rejoice and praise God that by his blood, Jesus has ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation (Rev. 5:9).

Other Gospel-Preaching Churches: Pray for other evangelical churches in our area. Pray they would continue to proclaim the excellencies of Christ and that they would remain committed to teach the whole counsel of God. Pray the Lord would continue to build his church and establish healthy local churches throughout Cincinnati and beyond.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

Congregational Singing

Congregational singing is commanded in the Bible (Eph. 5:19). We choose songs and melodies that help our congregation to know and enjoy God, recognize the work of His Son Jesus, and reflect on simple biblical truths.
