WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together especially as we go through this time of transition in our church (John 17:20-26).

Our Generosity: Ask that the Lord would grow our church in having generous hearts. May the abundance of God's goodness to us overflow in giving of our time, talent, and treasure. May we give cheerfully, not under compulsion. May the Lord see fit to use our gifts for his good purpose of building his kingdom (2 Corinthians 8-9)

Our Sanctification: As you face trials of various kinds, pray that you would remain steadfast and immovable in the hope of the gospel (Romans 5:3). Pray that you would make every effort to supplement your faith with godly virtues (2 Peter 1:5). As you have been set free from slavery to sin, pray that you will follow your new master Christ all the more (Romans 6).

A Witnessing Church: Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips and that we will always be prepared to give reasons for the hope that is in us (1 Peter 3:15). Ask that many doors will open for the word and that we will declare the mystery of Christ with clarity and winsomeness (Colossians 3:3-4). Pray that many unbelievers who visit our church and interact with our people will be converted and able to say, "We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the Savior of the world" (John 4:42).

Our Staff: Pray for the faithful men and women who serve on staff at Faith Church. Thank God for their gospel partnership and willingness to lead, serve behind-the-scenes to support our church, minister God's Word, and shepherd the flock (Philippians 1:3-5). Pray for them to be encouraged and find joy in their work. Pray that they will serve in the strength that God supplies and that in everything they do God will be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Peter 4:11).
