WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Luke 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Romans 8:26).

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Philippians 4:19) and make us faithful stewards of the finances he has entrusted to our church. Pray that we as a church would be faithful to contribute to the needs of the saints (Romans 13:12) giving cheerfully, generously, and sacrificially (1 Corinthians 16:2; 2 Corinthians 8:1-5, 12; 9:6-7).

The Elders and the Search Team: Continue to pray for the elders and the search team as they begin working towards a new lead pastor. Pray that the Spirit will give them wisdom and skill as they think through the process.

Marriages in Our Church: Pray that husbands in our church would live with their wives with humility and in an understanding way (1 Peter 3:7). Pray that husbands would love their wives just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her (Ephesians 5:25). Pray that wives would respect their husbands (Ephesians 5:33) and that they would submit to their husbands as unto the Lord (Ephesians 5:22-23).

New Members: Pray for the incoming members introduced to the congregation at the last meeting. May the Lord knit their hearts to ours in gospel-fueled love. May we care well for their needs, bear up with their weaknesses, and spur them on to greater holiness (Ephesians 4:32; Romans 15:1; 1 Thessalonians 5:11). May our various gifts build up the body of Christ in love (1 Corinthians 12).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Sermon

Our preaching is distinctly "Christ-centered," which means our aim is to see how every passage finds its fulfillment in Christ, His person, and work (Lk. 24:25-27; 44-48). We encourage you to pay careful attention to the sermon, with an inquisitive mind and eager heart.
