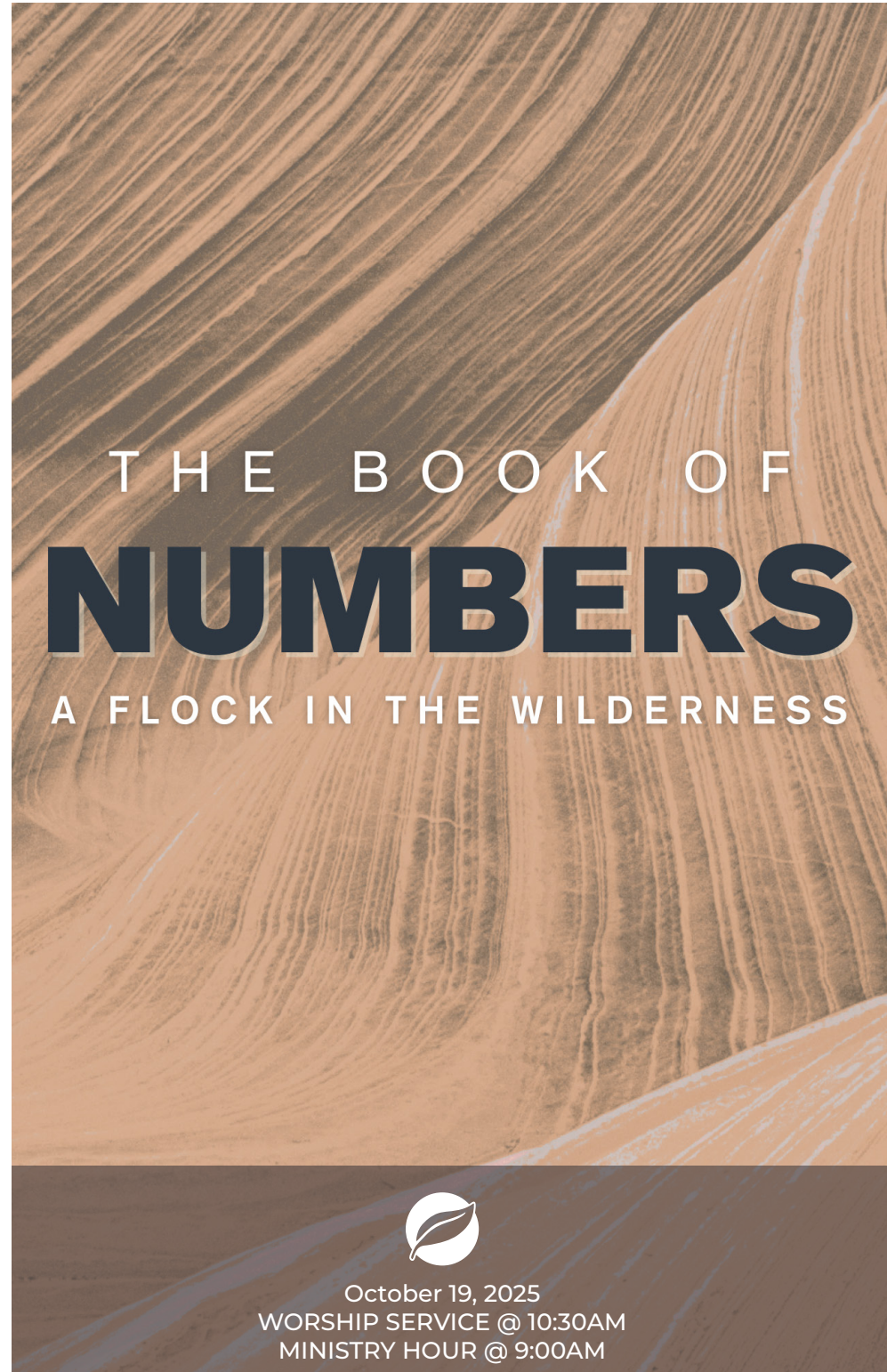


Monthly Prayer Service

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Governing Authorities: Pray for our current governing authorities like President Trump and Governor Mike DeWine (1 Timothy 2:1-4). Pray that they would lead with wisdom and virtue. Pray for a just government, “so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity.”

For Faith Church Parents: Pray for all those raising children in Faith Church. Pray that each parent would see their children as a blessing and heritage from the Lord (Psalm 127). Pray that our parents would faithfully raise their children in the “discipline and instruction of the Lord” (Ephesians 6:4). Pray that the children of Faith Church would come to faith in Jesus.

Our Congregational Singing: Pray we would be a church that delights to “sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly” (Psalm 149:1). Pray that we would sing with full hearts as an act of love toward God and one another. Pray we would see our singing on Sundays as expressions of our faith and thankfulness to God and as a means to teach, admonish, and encourage one another (Ephesians 5:18-20).

Our Love and Discernment: Pray that Faith Church will grow abundantly in love for the Lord and for one another (Mark 12:30-31). May we put the interests of others over our own interests (Philippians 2:4). In doing that, may we be increasingly like Jesus (Philippians 2:5). In addition to this, may our discernment grow all the more (Philippians 2:9). May we approve what is excellent and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ (Philippians 2:10).

Ashley Friedland, Southeast Asia: Praise God that he has given Ashley opportunities to grow in Christian fellowship and attend a conference focused on handling God’s Word rightly! Pray that God would help Ashley speak the gospel with courage and fearlessness to classmates and other locals (Philippians 1:14). Pray that the Lord would strengthen her in every good work and word (2 Thessalonians 2:17), especially in learning the language. Pray that the Lord would cause her to prosper in every way and remain in good health (3 John 2).

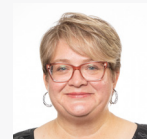

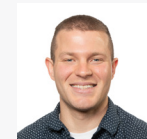

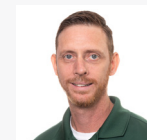
