WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Love and Discernment: Pray that Faith Church will grow abundantly in love for the Lord and for one another (Mark 12:30-31). May we put the interests of others above our own interests (Philippians 2:4) and in doing so may we be increasingly like Jesus (Philippians 2:5). In addition to this, may our discernment grow all the more (Philippians 2:9). May we approve what is excellent and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ (Philippians 2:10).

Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Luke 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Romans 8:26).

Karen Norton, AIA, Ohio: Karen has been back in the States and home with us at Faith Church for 3 months now. Since she has been back, she had a ten-week sabbatical and has now had a few weeks back at the AIA HQ in Xenia. Her sabbatical included lots of traveling to see friends and family. For the upcoming year, Karen will continue to work in the soccer department of AIA and has some international travel coming up. She will help lead a women's leadership academy (for collegiate soccer) and plan a tournament in preparation for the 2026 World Cup. Pray for her as she settles back into work in Xenia that she would be a diligent worker and content as she is away from Albania.

Eternal Perspective: While our lives are objectively short and eternity is objectively long, we tend to forget to live with an eternal perspective (Revelation 4:8). Ask that the Lord would equip Faith Church with hearts that care about eternity. When we studied Ecclesiastes, we were reminded to grow in our reckoning with death and the shortness of "life under the sun". As we encounter the fleeting nature of life, may we grow in our steadfast-anchor-of-the-soul hope in our resurrection life with Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:6-10).

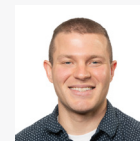

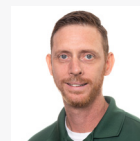
