WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Thanksgiving Holiday: Pray for sweet times of fellowship with friends and family. Pray for opportunities to have gospel related conversations with those that need to hear the good news and the hope we have through Christ. Also, pray for those that have lost loved ones. May we, as a church family, be instruments of Christ's compassion: lifting one another up, offering grace, and walking alongside those whose hearts are tender this season.

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together (John 17:20-26). May our gospel unity be a powerful witness to the truth of Jesus' love.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

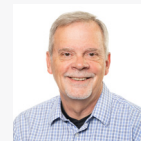
Gospel Liturgy

"Liturgy" literally means "the work of the people" or "public" (leito) "works" (ergos). Author Bryan Chapell defines it as the public way a church honors God in its times of gathered praise, prayer, instruction, and commitment. It's the work of the people to give praise and honor that God is due. We use "gospel liturgy" to mean that its parts work together to disciple people in the movements of the gospel: God; Man; Christ; Response. These four elements shape our worship services, which we want to humble us and exalt the grace of God that is in Christ Jesus. Our hope each week is for people to be formed and re-formed by the gospel of Jesus Christ.

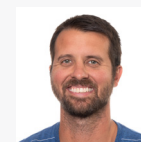
