WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Marriages in Our Church: Pray that husbands in our church would live with their wives with humility and in an understanding way (1 Pet. 3:7). Pray that husbands would love their wives just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her (Eph. 5:25). Pray that wives would respect their husbands (Eph. 5:33) and that they would submit to their husbands as unto the Lord (Eph. 5:22-23).

Our Elders: Pray that our elders will have great wisdom as they seek to lead our church through this next season. Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Tim. 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Pet. 5:2-3).

A Witnessing Church: Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips and that we will always be prepared to give reasons for the hope that is in us (1 Pet. 3:15). Ask that many doors will open for the word and that we will declare the mystery of Christ with clarity and winsomeness (Col. 3:3-4). Pray that many unbelievers who visit our church and interact with our people will be converted and able to say, "We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the Savior of the world" (John 4:42).

Hope for the Discouraged: Pray for those who are hurting, discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless within our church family. Pray that they would know God's love for them (Eph. 3:14-19). Pray that they would sense the nearness of God (Ps. 34:18). Pray that they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Pet. 1:3-6). Pray that our church would wrap our arms around them (Rom. 12:10-15).

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phil. 4:19) and make us faithful stewards of the finances he has entrusted to our church. Pray that we as a church would be faithful to contribute to the needs of the saints (Rom. 13:12) giving cheerfully, generously, and sacrificially (1 Cor. 16:2; 2 Cor. 8:1-5, 12; 9:6-7).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Passing the Peace

One of the most important effects of the Gospel is not only our unity with God but our unity with one another (Ephesians 2:14-22; Galatians 3:28-29). The peace we have vertically with God overflows into horizontal peace with others (Luke 2:14). As Christ has welcomed each of us into His family, so we too welcome each other (Romans 15:7). During the greeting time, we take a few moments to warmly greet each other with the peace of Christ.

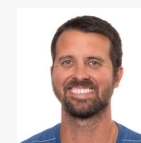
