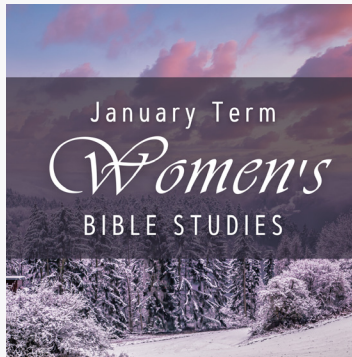


Benevolence Team Table

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Marriages in Our Church: Pray that husbands in our church would live with their wives with humility and in an understanding way (1 Pet. 3:7). Pray that husbands would love their wives just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her (Eph. 5:25). Pray that wives would respect their husbands (Eph. 5:33) and that they would submit to their husbands as unto the Lord (Eph. 5:22-23).

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously give new and eternal life to particular unbelievers who are connected to our members as we welcome them to church or in our homes (John 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mark 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Our Governing Authorities: Pray for our current governing authorities like President Trump and Governor Mike DeWine (1 Timothy 2:1-4). Pray that they would lead with wisdom and virtue. Pray for a just government, “so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity.”

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together especially as we go through this time of transition in our church (John 17:20-26).

FOCUS Ministry in the Middle East: Pray for our supported workers Nisin and Joanna Matthew and Tobin and Binita Mattacal as they work in this ministry. As they seek to reach students for Christ and connect them to local churches, pray for more Bible studies, more converts, and more growth through the churches of the country.

Sermon
