WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A Loving Church: Pray that we will love the Lord our God with all our hearts, all our souls, all our minds, and all our strength and that we will love our neighbor as ourselves (Mark 12:30-31). Ask that as a church we will put on that love which binds everything together in perfect harmony (Colossians 3:14). Pray that our love will naturally lead to a fulfillment of the law (Romans 13:9-10) and that we will love one another earnestly from a pure heart (1 Peter 1:22) that by this all men may know that we are Christ's disciples (John 13:35).

Our Community Groups: Pray that our CGs would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced and preserved. Pray for individuals within CGs to eagerly practice the "one-anothers" of the New Testament – such as, love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another's burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).

The Suffering: Pray for those who are experiencing a wide range of suffering among us. Pray for those with prolonged and chronic sickness. Pray for those who are fainthearted and tempted to despair. Pray for infertile couples in the congregation who are discouraged. Pray for those who have suffered miscarriages. Pray for those dealing with the grief that lingers from the death of a spouse, child, or family member. Pray for parents of wayward adult children.

Advent Evangelism: As our culture celebrates the Christmas season, pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips. Pray that we would develop gospel-oriented relationships and seize opportunities to proclaim the good news to those around us (Acts 4:23-31). Pray that we would increasingly find ways to weave our lives into the lives of those who need Christ.

The Elders and the Search Team: Please continue to pray for our Elders and the Search Team as they are in the process of finding our next Lead Pastor. Pray specifically that the Holy Spirit grants them wisdom, clear guidance, and discernment as they navigate every step of this important process.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Assurance of Pardon

After the confession, there will be an assurance of pardon moment. Often this will be taken from the scriptures, assuring Christians that God has pardoned their guilt, taken their sin away, and accepts them as His children forever (Psalm 103:1-8; Luke 7:48-50; John 3:16-17). Open your heart, each week, to be reminded of God's gracious pardon.

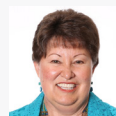

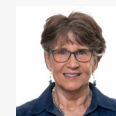

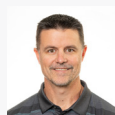
