## WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

**For the Nations:** Pray that all the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord and that every family of every nation will worship the Lord (Psalm 22:27). Pray that every people, nation, and language will serve King Jesus (Dan. 7:14). Choose one nation in particular and pray for it each day this week that Jesus might be glorified there and much good would come to the people. Rejoice and praise God that by his blood, Jesus has ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation (Rev. 5:9).

**Our Sanctification:** As you face trials of various kinds, pray that you would remain steadfast and immovable in the hope of the gospel (Romans 5:3). Pray that you would make every effort to supplement your faith with godly virtues (2 Peter 1:5). As you have been set free from slavery to sin, pray that you will follow your new master Christ all the more (Romans 6).

**Our Community Groups:** Pray that our CGs would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced and preserved. Pray for individuals within CGs to eagerly practice the “one-anothers” of the New Testament – such as, love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another’s burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).

**Our Children & Youth:** Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray we would see them as a gift from the Lord. Pray that our children will come to Jesus and enter his kingdom (Matt. 10:13-16). Pray their parents would be faithful to raise them in the fear and instruction of the Lord (Eph. 6:4). Pray for protection against the schemes of the devil and the pressures of the world that are especially challenging to our youth (Eph. 6:11). Pray that they will flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace (2 Tim. 2:22).

**Ed and Linda Cox - Navigators, Indiana:** Linda’s health is failing and she has been on a steady decline over the last few weeks. She is currently receiving hospice care at home and is unresponsive. Ed’s request is that we pray for Linda to have great peace as she awaits meeting her dear Savior. ### Confession of Sin & Prayer of Confession

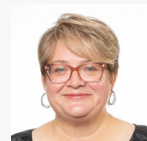

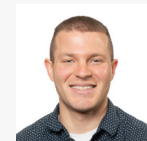

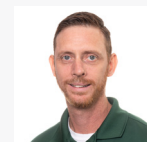
