WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Faith Church Short-term Mission Trip: Pray for the team that will be assisting Chris Phillips with a missionary pastors' conference this week in Thailand. Pray for the international pastors and families attending this conference to be encouraged and better equipped to lead their congregations. Pray for Pastor Drew and the team as they visit and encourage Ashley and the Phillips family. Pray for safe travels and much fruit to come from this trip!

Marriages in Our Church: Pray that husbands in our church would live with their wives with humility and in an understanding way (1 Pet. 3:7). Pray that husbands would love their wives just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her (Eph. 5:25). Pray that wives would respect their husbands (Ephesians 5:33) and that they would submit to their husbands as unto the Lord (Ephesians 5:22-23).

Our Children & Youth: Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray we would see them as a gift from the Lord. Pray that our children will come to Jesus and enter his kingdom (Matt. 10:13-16). Pray their parents would be faithful to raise them in the fear and instruction of the Lord (Eph. 6:4). Pray for protection against the schemes of the devil and the pressures of the world that are especially challenging to our youth (Eph. 6:11). Pray that they will flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace (2 Tim. 2:22).

New Members: Pray for the incoming members introduced to the congregation at the last meeting. May the Lord knit their hearts to ours in gospel-fueled love. May we care well for their needs, bear up with their weaknesses, and spur them on to greater holiness (Eph. 4:32; Rom. 15:1; 1 Thess. 5:11). May our various gifts build up the body of Christ in love (1 Cor. 12).

A Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Luke 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Rom. 8:26).

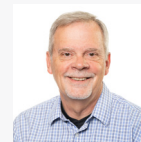
Gospel Liturgy

"Liturgy" literally means "the work of the people" or "public" (leitō) "works" (ergos). Author Bryan Chapell defines it as the public way a church honors God in its times of gathered praise, prayer, instruction, and commitment. It's the work of the people to give praise and honor that God is due. We use "gospel liturgy" to mean that its parts work together to disciple people in the movements of the gospel: God; Man; Christ; Response. These four elements shape our worship services, which we want to humble us and exalt the grace of God that is in Christ Jesus. Our hope each week is for people to be formed and re-formed by the gospel of Jesus Christ.
