WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Luke 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Rom. 8:26).

Iran: Pray for justice and peace in the ongoing war in Iran. May the Lord see fit to bring about a government in Iran that manages to maintain law and order in a way that truly punishes wickedness and promotes goodness (Rom. 13:2-4). May a government emerge that enables Christian Iranians to "lead tranquil and quiet lives in all godliness and dignity" (1 Tim 2:2).

Our Workers in the Middle East: Pray for the student ministry FOCUS and Redeemer Church of Kuwait. May Tobin and Nisin be faithful, courageous, and safe as they seek to live and do ministry amidst danger. Pray for Mitchell Cooper, the pastor of the Kuwait church, that he will be sustained by God's abundant grace.

Our Elders: Pray that our elders will have great wisdom as they seek to lead our church through this season. Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Tim. 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Pet. 5:2-3).

The Suffering: Pray for those who are experiencing a wide range of suffering among us. Pray for those with prolonged and chronic sickness. Pray for those who are fainthearted and tempted to despair. Pray for infertile couples in the congregation who are discouraged. Pray for those who have suffered miscarriages. Pray for those dealing with the grief that lingers from the death of a spouse, child, or family member. Pray for parents of wayward adult children.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Sermon

We trust that God the Spirit works through the preaching of God's Word to show us Christ, strengthen His people, and provoke non-Christians. Our aim in expository preaching is to "expose" the main point of the passage. The emphasis, organization, tone, and applications of the sermon text ought to be the emphasis, organization, tone, and applications of the sermon. Our preaching is distinctly "Christ-centered," which means our aim is to see how every passage finds its fulfillment in Christ, His person, and work (Lk. 24:25-27; 44-48). We encourage you to pay careful attention to the sermon, with an inquisitive mind and eager heart.
