Save the date for our Annual Vacation Bible School this summer! This exciting week is for kids going into kindergarten-4th grade. Older kids and teens could sign up to help.



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Marriages in Our Church: Pray that husbands in our church would live with their wives with humility and in an understanding way (1 Pet. 3:7). Pray that husbands would love their wives just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her (Eph. 5:25). Pray that wives would respect their husbands (Ephesians 5:33) and that they would submit to their husbands as unto the Lord (Ephesians 5:22-23).

A Witnessing Church: Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips and that we will always be prepared to give reasons for the hope that is in us (1 Peter 3:15). Ask that many doors will open for the word and that we will declare the mystery of Christ with clarity and winsomeness (Colossians 3:3-4). Pray that many unbelievers who visit our church and interact with our people will be converted and able to say, "We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the Savior of the world" (John 4:42).

Iran: Pray for justice and peace in the ongoing war in Iran. May the Lord see fit to bring about a government in Iran that manages to maintain law and order in a way that truly punishes wickedness and promotes goodness (Rom. 13:2-4). May a government emerge that enables Christian Iranians to "lead tranquil and quiet lives in all godliness and dignity" (1 Tim 2:2).

Our Partners in the Middle East: Pray for the student ministry FOCUS and Redeemer Church of Kuwait. May Tobin and Nisin be faithful, courageous, and safe as they seek to live and do ministry amidst danger. Pray for Mitchell Cooper, the pastor of the Kuwait church, that he will be sustained by God's abundant grace.

Other Gospel-Preaching Churches: Pray for other evangelical churches in our area. Pray they would continue to proclaim the excellencies of Christ and that they would remain committed to teach the whole counsel of God. Pray the Lord would continue to build his church and establish healthy local churches throughout Cincinnati and beyond.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

Call to Worship & Prayer of Adoration

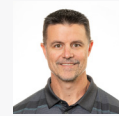

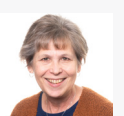
