WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Love and Discernment: Pray that Faith Church will grow abundantly in love for the Lord and for one another (Mark 12:30-31). May we put the interests of others over our own interests (Phil. 2:4). In doing that, may we be increasingly like Jesus (Phil. 2:5). In addition to this, may our discernment grow all the more (Phil 2:9). May we approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ (Phil 2:10).

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously give new and eternal life to particular unbelievers who are connected to our members as we welcome them to church and in our homes (John 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mark 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Our Community Groups: Pray that our CGs would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced and preserved. Pray for individuals within CGs to eagerly practice the “one-anothers” of the New Testament – such as, love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another’s burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).

Iran: Pray for justice and peace in the ongoing war in Iran. May the Lord see fit to bring about a government in Iran that manages to maintain law and order in a way that truly punishes wickedness and promotes goodness (Rom. 13:2-4). May a government emerge that enables Christian Iranians to “lead tranquil and quiet lives in all godliness and dignity” (1 Tim 2:2).

Our Partners in the Middle East: Pray for the student ministry FOCUS and Redeemer Church of Kuwait. May Tobin and Nisin be faithful, courageous, and safe as they seek to live and do ministry amidst danger. Pray for Mitchell Cooper, the pastor of the Kuwait church, that he will be sustained by God’s abundant grace.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Confession of Sin & Prayer of Confession

God commands His people to continually confess their sins to Him (1 John 1:9). The service leader will lead us in a moment of confession (often a short time of silence for self-examination and private confession). This may also include scripture reading, a responsive prayer of confession, or a corporate prayer of confession that the service leader will lead. We want to be a people who continually repent of their sins and experience the mercy of God! Lean into this moment.
