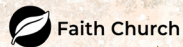

## WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

**Marriages in Our Church:** Pray that husbands in our church would live with their wives with humility and in an understanding way (1 Pet. 3:7). Pray that husbands would love their wives just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her (Eph. 5:25). Pray that wives would respect their husbands (Ephesians 5:33) and that they would submit to their husbands as unto the Lord (Ephesians 5:22-23).

**For Faith Church Parents:** Pray for all the families at Faith Church who are raising children. Pray that each parent would see their children as a blessing and heritage from the Lord (Psalm 127). Pray that our parents would faithfully raise their children in the “discipline and instruction of the Lord” (Ephesians 6:4). Pray that the children of Faith Church would come to faith in Jesus.

**Our Staff:** Pray for the faithful men and women who serve on staff at Faith Church. Thank God for their gospel partnership and willingness to lead, serve behind-the-scenes to support our church, minister God’s Word, and shepherd the flock (Phil. 1:3-5). Pray that they will serve in the strength that God supplies and that in everything they do God will be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 4:11).

Choose one nation in particular and pray for it each day this week that Jesus might be glorified there and much good would come to the people. Rejoice and praise God that by his blood, Jesus has ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation (Rev. 5:9).

**Men and Women’s Bible Studies:** Pray for the many Bible studies happening within Faith Church. Pray that our men and women receive abundant encouragement from God’s Word (Romans 15:4). Pray that God would make each of us mature and equipped for every good work he has planned for us (2 Timothy 3:17).

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### The Lord’s Supper

We take the Lord’s Supper each week to remind one another of the Lord’s death, by proclaiming it through the bread and the cup (1 Corinthians 11:17-34). To keep this from becoming rote, think deeply about what the bread and cup represent: the broken bread illustrates his broken body and the cup portrays his shed blood. Recognize your great need for a Merciful Savior. Celebrate the good news of the Cross.

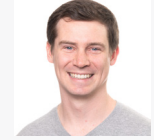
