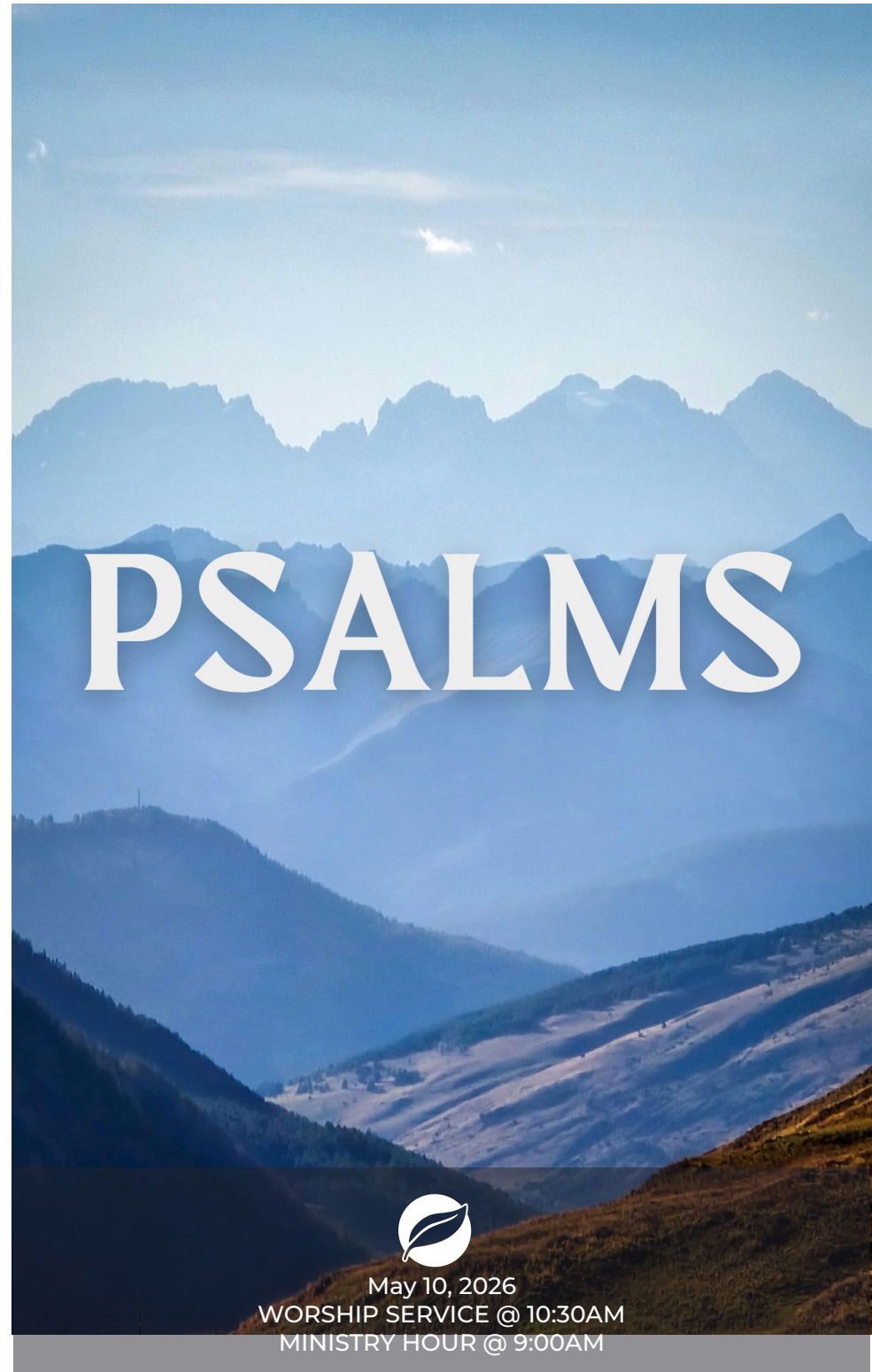

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

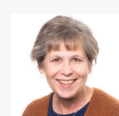
