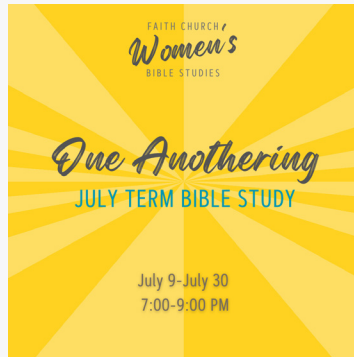
Monthly Prayer Service

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

VBS: Thank you for your prayers for VBS last week. Pray that God would bring fruit from our efforts to share the gospel with children and parents who do not know Jesus. May he draw some out of darkness and into his marvelous light (1 Pet 2:9).

The Suffering: Pray for those who are experiencing a wide range of suffering among us. Pray for those with prolonged and chronic sickness. Pray for those who are fainthearted and tempted to despair. Pray for infertile couples in the congregation who are discouraged. Pray for those who have suffered miscarriages. Pray for those dealing with the grief that lingers from the death of a spouse, child, or family member. Pray for parents of wayward adult children.

Our Congregational Singing: Pray we would be a church that delights to “sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly” (Ps. 149:1). Pray that we would sing with full hearts as an act of love toward God and one another. Pray we would see our singing on Sundays as expressions of our faith and thankfulness to God and as a means to teach, admonish, and encourage one another (Eph. 5:18-20).

A Witnessing Church: Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips and that we will always be prepared to give reasons for the hope that is in us (1 Peter 3:15). Ask that many doors will open for the word and that we will declare the mystery of Christ with clarity and winsomeness (Colossians 3:3-4). Pray that many unbelievers who visit our church and interact with our people will be converted and able to say, “We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the Savior of the world” (John 4:42).

Austin & Morgan Sides, On Goal, Milford: Weekly soccer camps are in full swing, and this week Austin has been in Allendale, MI. Please pray for Gideon and John, two 10-year-olds, who both repented of their sins and trusted in Christ this week. Pray that Allendale Baptist, their partner church for this week’s camp, would care for them well and disciple them into maturity. Pray for Morgan as she is home with their children, that she would radiate the joy of Christ to her children and would not grow weary of her good work in raising them.

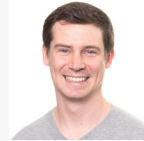

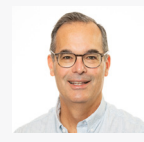
