WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A Witnessing Church: Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips and that we will always be prepared to give reasons for the hope that is in us (1 Peter 3:15). Ask that many doors will open for the word and that we will declare the mystery of Christ with clarity and winsomeness (Colossians 3:3-4). Pray that many unbelievers who visit our church and interact with our people will be converted and able to say, "We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the Savior of the world" (John 4:42).

For Faith Church Parents: Pray for all the families at Faith Church who are raising children. Pray that each parent would see their children as a blessing and heritage from the Lord (Psalm 127). Pray that our parents would faithfully raise their children in the "discipline and instruction of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4). Pray that the children of Faith Church would come to faith in Jesus.

National Revival: Pray that God would be merciful and bring many in our nation to saving faith in Jesus. Pray the church would be a faithful and bold witness for the gospel in our land. Pray that righteousness would exalt our nation (Proverbs 34:14).

Our Staff: Pray for the faithful men and women who serve on staff at Faith Church. Thank God for their gospel partnership and willingness to lead, serve behind-the-scenes to support our church, minister God's Word, and shepherd the flock (Phil. 1:3-5). Pray for them to be encouraged and find joy in their work. Pray that they will serve in the strength that God supplies and that in everything they do God will be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 4:11).

A Loving Church: Pray we will love the Lord our God with all our hearts, all our souls, all our minds, and all our strength. Pray we will love our neighbor as ourselves (Mark 12:30-31). Ask that as a church we will put on that love which binds everything together in perfect harmony (Col. 3:14). Pray that we will love one another earnestly from a pure heart (1 Peter 1:22) that by this all men may know that we are Christ's disciples (John 13:35).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Call to Worship & Prayer of Adoration

We do not invite ourselves to worship God; rather, God has called us to worship Him. God initiates; we respond. He has the first and last word in meeting with us. Thus, the call to worship is often a scripture reading where God invites us to worship Him, through Jesus. This will be followed by a prayer of adoration, which recognizes and praises God in all of His greatness and glory. Please use these opening moments to quiet your hearts and focus on the Godhead.
